Help Stop Hate officially launched on Oct. 30, 2024 as a statewide initiative aimed at raising awareness and encouraging the public to report acts of hate they witness or experience.

As part of this effort, Help Stop Hate is launching a new campaign to send a clear message: ***Not in Our State***. Hate has no place in Illinois. Through education, outreach, and engagement, this campaign empowers communities to stand against acts of hate in all its forms.

As a valued stakeholder, you play a critical role in amplifying this message. This toolkit provides ready-to-use content to help you spread awareness and drive action in your networks.

What is ***Help Stop Hate***?

Help Stop Hate is a confidential service that provides meaningful support to assist victims and witnesses of hate acts in reporting what happened and connecting them and their communities with vital resources.

The service is free, confidential, and not affiliated with law enforcement.

Online reports can be made in English and Spanish.

Callers can report in the language of their preference and receive assistance from call specialists trained in trauma-informed care.

Help Stop Hate is a project of the Illinois Commission on Discrimination and Hate Crimes (CDHC) and the Illinois Department of Human Rights (IDHR).

In response, Governor JB Pritzker, along with the Illinois Human Rights Department (IDHR) and the Illinois Commission on Discrimination and Hate Crimes (CDHC), announced the official launch of Help Stop Hate, a confidential service that provides support and resources to individuals and communities affected by hate.

Help Stop Hate provides meaningful support to assist victims and witnesses of hate acts in reporting what happened and connecting them and their communities with vital resources. The service is free, confidential, and not affiliated with law enforcement. Online reports can be made in seven languages. Callers can report in the language of their preference and receive assistance from call specialists trained in trauma-informed care.

Hate has no place in Illinois – but we need your help to ensure our communities remain safe and inclusive for all. By speaking up and reporting hate acts you witness or experience, you play a crucial role in making Illinois a place where everyone is treated with dignity and respect.
